



Impact Arts will be running free creative workshops for 14-19 year olds in Edinburgh this July and August.

Lasting four weeks, Cashback to the Future will give young people the chance to work with artists and tutors on **music, performance and visual art projects**. The programme is based on Impact Arts' successful Gallery 37 model.

Workshops will be run at the **National Museum of Scotland** between **11th July and 4th August 2017** (running **Tuesday - Friday, 9.30am until 4pm**).

Impact Arts are now looking for referrals and sign-ups for the programme. Participants will have to meet one of the following criteria:

- Not in employment, education or training
- At risk of disengaging from school
- At risk of engaging in anti-social behaviour
